To make sure that there are as few complications as possible in the notification process, it's important to gather as much of the following information as you can about the person who has died:

☐ Full name
Address
Date and place of birth and death
Date of marriage or civil partnership
Recent occupation
☐ National Insurance number
☐ NHS number
Tax reference number
Passport details
Driving licence details
